To ensure that the research we publish is accurate, transparent, responsibly produced, and aligned with international ethical guidelines, this letter aims to provide clarity on our processes, share best practices, and offer guidance to help you navigate ethical considerations with confidence throughout the publication journey.

Recently, we have seen an alarming increase in AI-generated peer reviews. Please note that our policy states that it is the peer reviewer's responsibility to ensure the accuracy and integrity of the research and to formulate their own opinions and recommendations. **The use of AI in any aspect of the peer review process, including evaluation, decision-making, and the generation of summaries or comments, is strictly prohibited**

Why can't AI support with peer reviews?

AI is particularly good at sorting, analyzing, and predicting data, but it lacks the independent thought and wisdom necessary to understand it. Without a full understanding of the content, the background research, the literature cited, the plausibility and applicability of the methodology, model, etc., AI cannot provide an accurate evaluation.

Moreover, manuscripts under peer review may contain sensitive or confidential information that should not be shared outside the peer review process. Uploading a manuscript to any generative Artificial Intelligence (AI) tool or service is a breach of confidentiality and privacy. IGI Global Scientific Publishing does not permit editors and peer reviewers to upload an unpublished manuscript or any information pertaining to the manuscript (files, images, data, etc.) into Generative AI tools.

What are we doing to combat AI-generated peer reviews?

Technological Updates

Shortly, reviewers will find a change to the peer review forms they are required to fill out. At the bottom of the form, there will be a new checkbox that each peer reviewer must check before the form can be submitted. This checkbox states:

IGI Global Scientific Publishing strictly prohibits the use of Artificial Intelligence (AI) or AI-assisted technologies in any phase of the peer review process. By selecting the checkbox below, you hereby acknowledge, affirm, and accept full responsibility for ensuring that no form of AI or AI-generated assistance was utilized in the conduct, preparation, or completion of the peer review for this chapter.

I hereby certify that Artificial Intelligence (AI) or any AI-assisted technology was *not* used in any capacity during the peer review of this chapter.

Moreover, the form now includes the contact information for the Publishing Ethics & Research Integrity Team, which authors may use to contact us directly should they believe their review was AI-generated.

Frequent Audits

The Publishing Ethics & Research Integrity Team are performing regular and frequent audits of the peer review process for both books and journals. Chapters or articles suspected of receiving an AI-generated peer review will be reassigned to new evaluators to ensure proper feedback is provided. Reviewers suspected of using AI to generate reviews will be investigated and are subject to penalties as outlined below.

Stricter Penalties

Reviewers who use AI to conduct the review for them will face stricter punishments including removal of recognition/credit for their review, a ban on their reviewing capabilities, and removal from the Editorial Board. Furthermore, the checkbox mentioned above puts the responsibility fully on the reviewer, meaning that they are solely liable in the event of wrongdoing.
